

ACT Prep Course (2012)



Course Overview:

This 9-week course covers all the essentials needed to be successful on the ACT. Utilizing real ACT questions and passages, each session will focus both on content (English, math, reading, science, or writing) and test-taking strategies. Commitment is absolutely necessary for success!

Registration:

The course will cost **\$140 per student**, which will also include an ACT prep book. Checks should be made payable to Mr. Steven Firchow and should be turned in to him no later than Thursday, February 2nd. When students turn in their payment, they will then choose which sessions to attend (Monday/Wednesdays or Tuesday/Thursdays). Each section will be capped at 20 students, so it is very important that everyone signs up as soon as possible to guarantee a spot in the class!
